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Notes on Designs and Formats

Each Anita Goodesign Cd-Rom contains: embroidery files, printable PDF Files for tutorials, color sheets, catalogs and copies of design pack art should you want to print them. The Design Files are located in a folder titled "DESIGN FILES". The following file conversions are included in each collection. Artista (art), Brother/Babylock (pes), Buzz Tools/PED Basic (pes), Husqvarna/Viking (hus), Janome(jef), Singer (xxx), Melco (exp), Husqvarna/Viking/Pfaff(vip) and Tajima(dst). **All of these files will not work on every machine. We include in each pack large versions of files and files with very high stitch counts. Due to limitations with some machines you may not be able to sew the larger versions of these designs.** If you have an older machine with a smaller hoop size you may have to split the design into two sections using editing software, we do not recommend doing this because it may ruin the integrity of the design. However most of the large designs are available in smaller versions for your convenience. If you have trouble or encounter errors when opening a specific file we suggest importing the (dst) file into your software and converting it into the desired format. dst files seem to have the least amount of errors when converting. Due to the extreme differences in software it is hard to guarantee that every file will convert properly. We don't recommend re-sizing designs. We have resized most of the designs for your convenience.

Buzz Tools - PED Basic - PTS Users

There is a folder under design files titled "Buzz Tools - PED Basic" that contains converted design files to be used in Buzz Tools editing software and older versions on Palette and PE Designs Software. If you plan on using older versions of PE Designs or Palette please use the files in this folder. All of the files are in this folder including the larger files. If you don't have a large enough hoop to embroider these files you still may not be able to sew them.

Brother - Babylock (PES)

We recommend the latest version of Palette or PE Designs to ensure success. You may encounter problems opening some of the jumbo designs directly in the machine. If you have trouble with this, open the designs in your software and then send them to your machines. This is a rotation problem with some machines.

All of the PES files have been converted to the proper colors. **We use Madeira rayon thread on all of the designs so in order for the colors to appear on your machine correctly you must set the thread to Madeira rayon.** There are large designs included in each collection that are exclusive for the Innovus 4000D, EMP6, Embroidery Professional and Ellegante. We also include smaller versions of each jumbo design for other machine hoop sizes. If you have trouble opening designs that are sideways we have included those designs rotated as well. They are signified with this wording (sized) in the title.

Bernina (ART)

All of the files come in (art). However the files weren't digitized using Bernina Software so you may encounter problems resizing. They are not true (art) files. These designs won't show up in the correct colors due to limitations in the software. Refer to the color sheets included as a.pdf file in the tutorials folder.

Husqvarna/Viking (HUS)

All of the files come in (hus). The designs should open without a problem and you will be limited only by the size of your hoop. These designs won't show up in the correct colors due to limitations in the software. Refer to the color sheets included as a pdf file in the tutorials folder.

Tajima/Melco (dst,exp)

All of the files come in these two commercial formats. These formats carry no color information so you will have to refer to the color sheets included in pdf format in the tutorials folder. These files maintain the highest integrity of any embroidery file, so if you are having trouble with the conversions we suggest importing the (dst) version into your software and converting it yourself to your machines format.

Singer (XXX)

All of the files come in the (xxx) format, however, due to limitations in hoop size and file size you may not be able to sew all of them and they may split into multiple designs. The conversions split themselves automatically into these formats and may require you to overlay multiple designs to insure correct embroidery. These designs won't show up in the correct colors due to limitations in the software, Refer to the color sheets included as a pdf file in the tutorials folder. If you have a new version of software or new machine with a greater memory capacity import the (dst) file into your software and convert it using your current software.

Husqvarna/Viking/Pfaff (VIP)

All of the files come in the (vip) format, however, due to limitations in hoop size and file size you may not be able to sew all of them and they may split into multiple designs. The conversions split themselves automatically into these formats and may require you to overlay multiple designs to insure correct embroidery. These designs won't show up in the correct colors due to limitations in the software. Refer to the color sheets included as a pdf file in the tutorials folder. If you have a new version of software or new machine with a greater memory capacity import the (dst) file into your software and convert it using your current software.

Pulse (PXF)

Some design collections will contain a folder with pulse pxf files. These files are intended to be used with the Tajima Ambassador program included on the CD Rom. These files are able to be resized using the Ambassador software. Before you attempt to use the Ambassador software please read the tutorial That is included on the CD-Rom. The outside of the package will tell you which collections come with the re-sizing program.

To ensure great embroidery follow these steps:

1. Always sample the design on fabric similar to the final fabric first. Never test embroidery directly on the final garment.
2. Always use good thread. Cheap thread can ruin a great design.
3. Hoop properly, bad hooping can cause problems such as poor design registration.

Opening your Designs

Due to the many different types of software on the market we cannot give precise instructions on how to open designs in your software. We suggest using cataloging software to keep track of all of your designs. Some good catalog software is Designers Gallery, Explorations, and Buzz Tools. These programs will help you keep track of your designs.

Opening Designs in Windows XP

Step 1 . Insert the Cd-Rom in your Cd-Rom Drive. Wait a few seconds and a screen will pop up showing you what is on the CD-Rom. Each CD-contains five folders: (Design Files), (Tutorials), (Licensing and design instructions), (Catalog), (resizing program)

(Design Files) contains all of the design formats in individual folders

(Tutorials) contains tutorials on specific techniques/projects and the color sheets and cover art

(Licensing and design instructions) contains permission form for production sewing and selling of designs and how to open designs

(Catalog) contains the current Anita Goodesign catalog of design collections.

(Re-Sizing Program) contains the re-sizing software program and the tutorial on how to use it.

(This software is only available on Home Decor collections)

Step 2 - Double click the folder titled **(Design Files)**. This will open up smaller file folders containing all of the individual formats in their own folders.

Step 3 - At this point you have two options, option one would be to open up your desired file folder and send individual designs to a floppy disk, or send the entire folder to your computer. If you send the whole folder to your computer you won't need the CD-Rom to open individual designs.

Step 4 - To view the design names and save them to a floppy disk double click the desired design folder. This will display a list of all of the designs. Locate the desired design and right click on it with your mouse. This brings up a few options. Select the "write to floppy disk" option and left click. This will send the selected design to your floppy drive. Repeat with as many designs as necessary.

Step 5 - To move the entire design folder to your hard drive follow steps 1 thru 3. When you see the design format folder that you want to transfer, right click on it and select "save in my documents". This action will move the entire folder to "my documents." Once the folder is there, simply start your sewing software and look for your new designs in that folder.

Older versions of Windows

If the CD-Rom doesn't open automatically.

Step 1 - Insert the CD-Rom into your CD-Rom Drive

Step 2 - Click on the **START** button on the lower left part of your screen.

Step 3 - Click on **My Computer**, It should be on the upper right portion of the pop-up menu.

Step 4 - Once you click on **My Computer**, a box will appear listing all of the drives on your computer.

Step 5 - Double Click on the icon that signifies the CD-Rom Drive

Step 6 - Go to Step 1 above and follow the instructions to move your design files.
