

## ROSE APPLIQUE



This set includes:

Rose Applique Alphabet - 4x4 Hoop

Blank Round Frame – 4x4 Hoop

Rose Applique design – 5x7 hoop with:

- Hers
- Mrs
- Mine
- Guest

Plain Oval frame – 5x7 hoop with:

- His
- Mr
- Yours

Blank Oval Frame – 5x7 hoop

Please feel free to add your own designs with the blanks.

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*Instructions are shown for how I applique on towels. (I float the towel over the hoop)*

*Please use whichever method you are comfortable with.*

## ROSE APPLIQUES

*The images show the 5x7 design, but the instruction and colors are exactly the same for the round 4x4 Rose*



Hoop Tear-away Stabiliser

Align and place your Towel over the hoop – the needle will be the centre mark

Thread machine with a neutral Color

***If your Towel is plush/chunky, you could place a piece of Solvy over the area before you baste***

Stitch Color 1 which is a basting stitch to attach your Towel – *skip this color if you hoop your items*

Stitch Color 2 which is the guideline for your Applique patch

Place your fabric over the guideline

Stitch Color 3 which attaches the Fabric



Using sharp scissors, cut away the excess fabric

Stitch Color 4 which  
Stitches a guideline for your Leaf Fabric



Place your Leaf fabric over the guidelines

Stitch Color 5 which  
Attaches the Leaf  
Fabric

Cut away the excess fabric

Place Rose Fabric over the guideline

Stitch Color 6 which attaches Rose Fabric

Cut away excess Fabric

Continue with your neutral color and  
Stitch Color 7 which zig zags the edges



Complete your design in your chosen colors

Color 8 – Satin Stitch edge – Madeira Rayon 1100

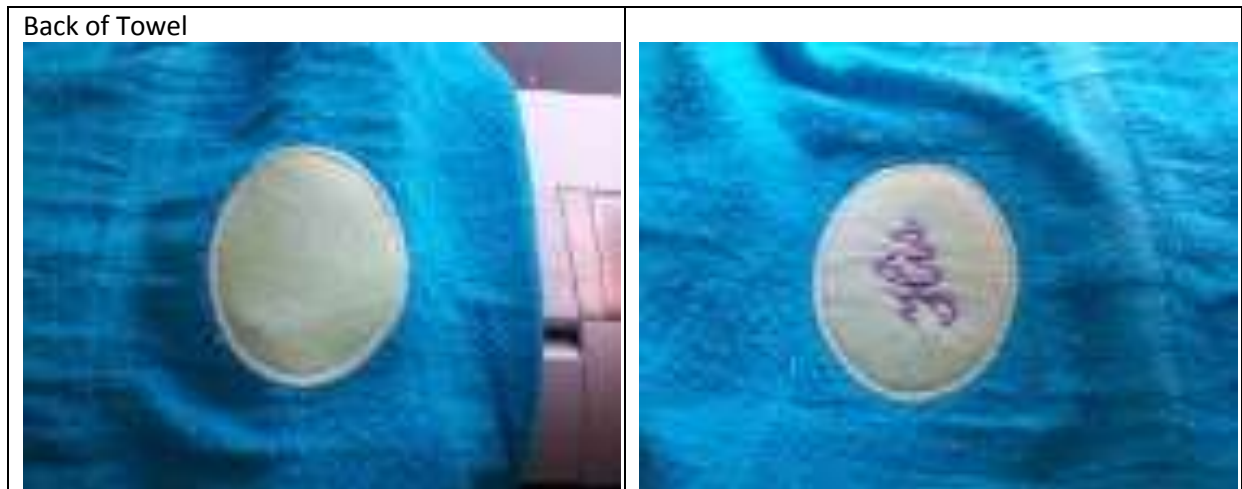
Color 9 – Leaves – Maderia Rayon 1396

Color 10 – Rose – Madeira Rayon 1032

Color 11 – Initial – Madeira Rayon 1302

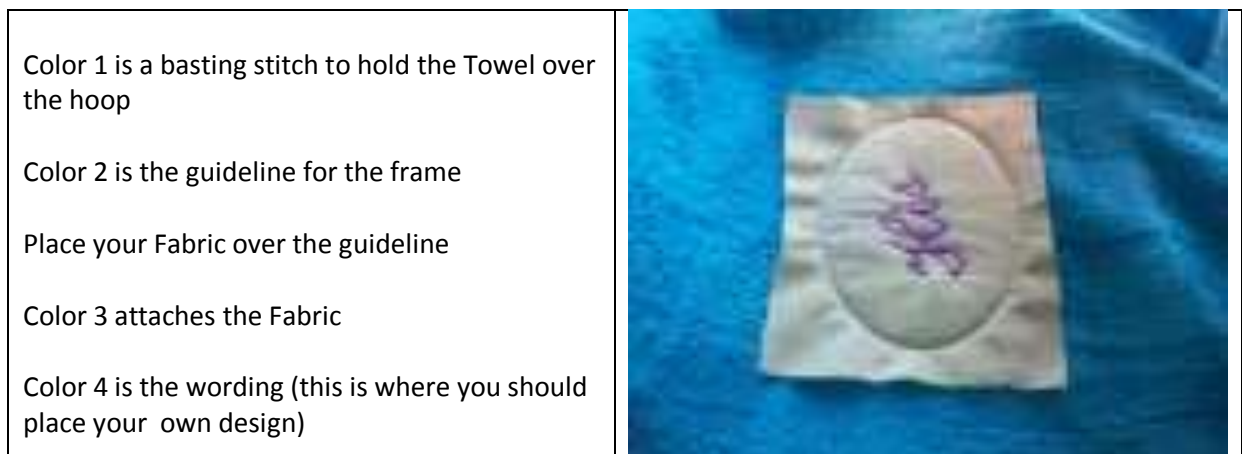
## PLAIN FRAMES

Feel free to add your own designs to these frames!



I've constructed these frames, so you can add fabric to the back of the design, so no stitching is shown on the back. *You could use a matching bobbin thread so the frame is 'pretty' on the front and back.*

As before:



Once you have embroidered your design/wording:



Remove hoop from machine and as pictured, tape your backing fabric over the stitched guideline

Return hoop to machine

Stitch Color 5 which attaches the backing

Remove hoop from machine again and cutaway excess fabric on front and back of design

Stitch Color 6 which zig zags then completes the Satin Stitch edging

I absolutely LOVE the Red and White we used on the Guest Towels, but.. my girls had bought me the Purple and Turquoise Candles so I could 'relax' in the bath. (So cute) so I used those Colors for them.
