Part One: Creating the House Applique

Creating the Components of the House:

1. Open up the Settings Page and change the Hoop to 9 ½” x 9 ½”

2. Click OK

3. Click IQ Designer



4. Click on the Shapes Icon

5. Select the Square  (Row 1 Column 1)

6. Click OK

7. Click Size

8. Reduce the H = 2.25”  and the W = 1.61” 

9. Click OK

10. Click the Eraser Icon



11. Reduce the number to 10 and Select the Square then Click OK


(for Destiny select the Smallest Square)

12. Delete the top part of the Rectangle and a bit of the right side of the rectangle

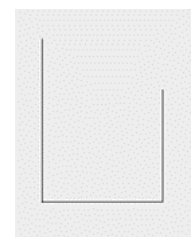
13. Make sure you do not move the design – otherwise the other pieces will not match up

14. Click on the Shapes Icon



15. Select the Triangle Shape  (Row 2 Column 4). We are now creating the Roof of the House

16. Click OK



17. Click Rotate

18. Rotate the Triangle 25 Degrees to the Right

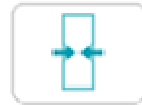
19. Click OK

20. Click Size

21. Reduce the Size to H = 1.33"



and W = 2.48"



22. While it is still select, move it above the House, overlapping it a bit

23. Click OK

24. Click on the Eraser Icon

25. Reduce the number to 10 and Select the Square then Click OK

(for Destiny select the Smallest Square)

26. You may want to zoom in to 400%

27. Delete the overlapping piece

28. Now Let's create the Chimney

29. Click on the Shapes Icon

30. Select the Square  (Row 1 Column 1)

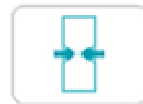
31. Click OK

32. Click Size

33. Reduce the Size to H = .75"



and W = .39"

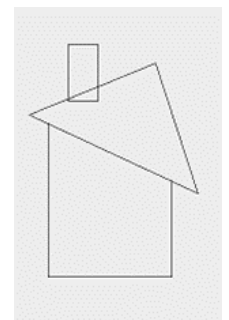
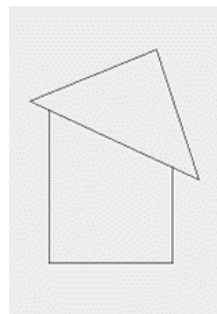
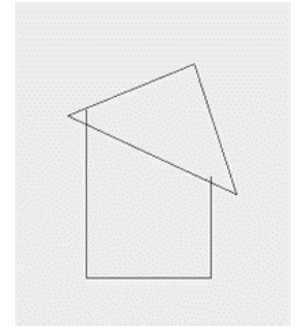


34. While it is still selected move it on top of the roof. Again overlapping the roof

35. Click OK

36. Click the Eraser Icon

37. Reduce the number to 10 and Select the Square then Click OK



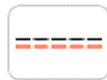
38. Zoom in to 800%

39. Delete the overlapping part as well as delete the Top part of the roof and the Right side of the roof

40. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



41. Select the Double Run Icon



42. Click on the Straight Line Icon



43. Click OK

44. Draw a line connecting the top part of the roof – The top of the roof is now angled

45. Click the Eraser Icon

46. Zoom to 100%

47. Delete any lines that extend beyond the design

48. Click on the Line Regions Property Icon



49. Click on the No Line Icon



50. Click OK

51. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

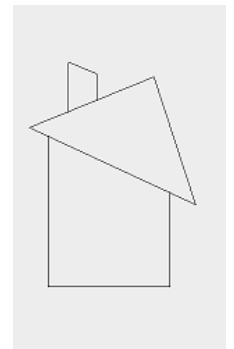
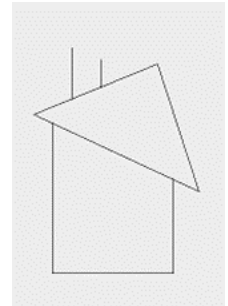
52. Touch the House

53. Click Memory then Click on the Machines Memory

(for the Destiny Click on the Pocket with the Red Arrow Machines Memory)



then click on Machine



Creating the House Applique (Placement Line):

1. Click on the Eraser Icon

2. Reduce the number to 10 and Select the Square then Click OK

(for Destiny select the Smallest Square)

3. Zoom in to 400%

4. Erase the Roof and the Chimney



5. Click on the Line Region Property Icon

6. Select the Double Run Icon



7. Change the Color to Red

8. Click OK

9. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon



10. Touch the Base of the House

11. Click Memory then Click on the Machines Memory

*(for the Destiny Click on the Pocket with the Red Arrow
Machines Memory)*



then click on Machine

12. Click Next

13. Click Set and Click OK when the message pop up

(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)

14. Click Add

Creating the House Applique (Satin Stitch Line):

1. Click IQ Designer

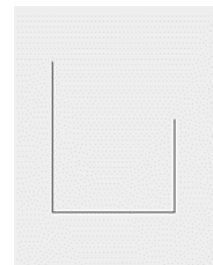
2. Click on the Pocket with the Arrow Icon



(For Destiny – Click on the Pocket with the Blue Arrow)



3. Click on Machines Memory – You should see one completed house and one Base of the House in Red



4. Click on the Base of the House

5. Click OK

6. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



7. Select the Satin Stitch Option

8. Change the Color to Green

9. Click OK



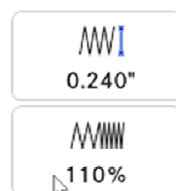
10. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

11. Touch the Base of the House

12. Click Next

13. Change the Zig Zag Width to .240"

14. Change the Density to 110%



(For Destiny – Click Set to make the changes)

15. Click Set and Click OK when the message pop up

(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)

16. You should see two colors in the color film – Red and Green

17. Click on Add

Creating the Chimney (Placement Line):

1. Click on IQ Designer

2. Click on the Pocket with the Arrow Icon



(For Destiny – Click on the Pocket with the Blue Arrow)



3. Select the Machines Memory

4. Select the Entire House
5. Click OK or Set depending on the machine
6. Click the Eraser Icon
7. Zoom to 400%



8. Erase the Roof and the Base of the House

9. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



10. Click on Double Run Icon



11. Change Color to Red

12. Click OK



13. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

14. Touch the Chimney

15. Click Memory then Click on the Machines Memory

(for the Destiny Click on the Pocket with the Red Arrow Machines Memory)



then click on Machine

16. Click on Next

17. Click Set and Click OK when the message pop up

(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)

18. At this point you should see three colors – Red – Green – Red

19. Click Add

Creating the Chimney (Satin Stitch):

1. Click on IQ Designer

2. Click on the Pocket with the Arrow Icon



(For Destiny – Click on the Pocket with the Blue Arrow)



3. Click on the Machines Memory
4. Select the Chimney
5. Click OK or Set depending on the machine

6. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



7. Select Satin Stitch
8. Change Color to Green
9. Click OK

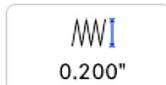


10. Click on Bucket/Cup Icon

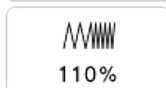
11. Touch the Chimney

12. Click on Next

13. Change the Zig Zag Width to .200"



14. Change the Density to 110%



For Destiny – Click on Set to make the changes

15. Click Set and Click OK when the message pop up

(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)

16. You should see 4 colors

17. Click Add

Creating the Roof (Placement Line):

1. Click on IQ Designer

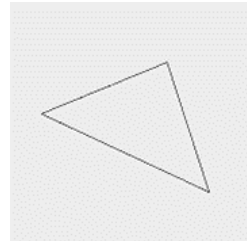
2. Click on the Pocket with the Arrow Icon



(For Destiny – Click on the Pocket with the Blue Arrow)



3. Select the Machines Memory
4. Select the Complete House
5. Click OK or Set depending on the machine
6. Click on the Eraser Icon
7. Zoom to 400%
8. Erase the Chimney and the Base of the House
You should be left with the Roof



9. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



10. Select the Double Run Icon



11. Change the Color to Red

12. Click OK



13. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

14. Touch the Roof

15. Click Memory then Click on the Machines Memory

*(for the Destiny Click on the Pocket with the Red Arrow
Machines Memory)*



then click on Machine

16. Click Next

17. Click Set and Click OK when the message pop up

(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)

18. Click Add

Creating the Roof (Satin Stitch):

1. Click on IQ Designer



2. Click on the Pocket with the Arrow Icon

(For Destiny – Click on the Pocket with the Blue Arrow)



3. Click on Machines Memory
4. Click on the Roof
5. Click on OK or Set depending on the machine

6. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



7. Change it to a Satin Stitch Fill

8. Change the Color to Green

9. Click on OK



10. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

11. Touch the Roof

12. Click on Next

13. Change the Zig Zag Width to .240"



14. Change the Density to 110%



For Destiny – Click on Set to make the changes

15. Click Set and Click OK when the message pop up

(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)

16. Click on the Memory Icon








17. Click on the Machines Memory

18. Click Home

Part Two: Digitizing the Mini Wall Hanging

Creating the Placement Line for the Batting:

1. Click on IQ Designer
2. At this point you will need the Grid – So go to the settings page where the grid is displayed. Change the Grid so that the 1” Grid marks are displayed. Click OK
3. Click on the Shapes Icon
4. Select the Square  (Row 1 Column 1)
5. Click OK
6. Click on Size and change the size so that the Square is 6” x 6” 
7. Click OK
8. Click on the Line Region Property Icon 
9. Select the Double Stitch Icon 
10. Change the Color to Red
11. Click OK 
12. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon 
13. Touch the Square
14. Click Memory then Click on the Machines Memory 
(for the Destiny Click on the Pocket with the Red Arrow Machines Memory) then click on Machine
15. Click on Next
16. Click Set and Click OK when the message pop up
(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)
17. Click Add

Creating the Tackdown Line for the Batting and Background Fabric:

1. Click on IQ Designer

2. Click on the Pocket with the Arrow Icon



(For Destiny – Click on the Pocket with the Blue Arrow)



3. Click on Machines Memory

4. Select the Red Square

5. Click OK or Set depending on the machine

6. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



7. Select the Double Stitch Icon



8. Change the Color to Blue

9. Click OK



10. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

11. Touch the Square

12. Click on Next

13. Click Set and Click OK when the message pop up

(For Destiny, Click on Preview, Next, OK, Set, OK)

14. Click Add

Creating the Four Borders:

1. Click IQ Designer

2. Click on the Pocket with the Arrow Icon



(For Destiny – Click on the Pocket with the Blue Arrow)

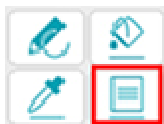


3. Click on the Machines Memory

4. Select the Red Square

5. Click OK or Set depending on the machine

6. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



7. Click on the No Sew Icon



8. Click OK

9. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon



10. Touch the Square

11. Click Memory then Click on the Machines Memory

*(for the Destiny Click on the Pocket with the Red Arrow
Machines Memory*



then click on Machine

HORIZONTAL BORDERS:

12. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



13. Click on Double Run Icon



14. Click on the Straight Line Icon



15. Change Color to Gold

16. Click OK

17. Select the Straight Line Icon to activate it

18. Draw a Horizontal Line 1" from the top of the Square – Don't worry
if you extend outside the Square – we can delete it later

19. Click on the Line Region Property Icon

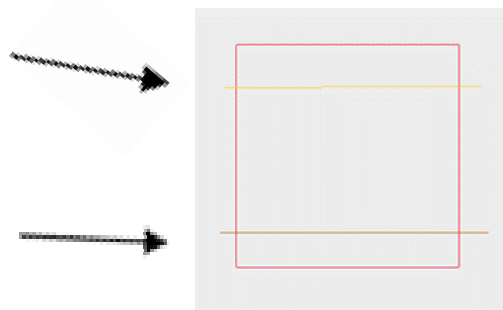
20. Click on Double Run Option

21. Click on the Straight Line Option

22. Change Color to Orange

23. Click OK

24. Select the Straight Line Icon



25. Draw a Horizontal Line 1” from the bottom of the Square
26. Click on the Eraser Icon
27. Delete any lines that extend beyond the Square – a little bit over is OK
28. Click Next
29. Click Set and Click OK when the message pop up
(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)

30. Click on Add

VERTICAL BORDERS:

31. Click on IQ Designer

32. Click on the Pocket with the Arrow Icon



(For Destiny – Click on the Pocket with the Blue Arrow)



33. Click on the Machines Memory
34. Select the Square (the color should be black)
35. Click OK or Set depending on the machine

36. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



37. Click on the No Sew Icon



38. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

39. Touch the Square

40. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



41. Click on Double Run Icon

42. Click on the Straight Line Icon



43. Change Color to Green

44. Click OK

45. Select the Straight Line Icon



46. Draw a Vertical Line 1" from left side of the Square

47. Click on the Line Region Property Icon

48. Click on Double Run Icon



49. Click on the Straight Line Icon

50. Change Color to Blue

51. Click OK

52. Select the Straight Line Icon

53. Draw a Vertical Line 1" from right side of the Square

54. Click on the Eraser Icon

55. Delete any lines that extend beyond the Square – a little bit over is OK

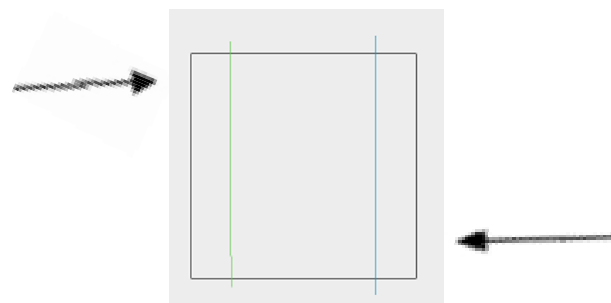
56. You may want to Zoom to 200%

57. Click Next

58. Click Set and Click OK when the message pop up

(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)

59. Click on Add



Creating the Placement Line for the Ribbon:

1. Click on IQ Designer

2. Click on the Pocket with the Arrow Icon



(For Destiny – Click on the Pocket with the Blue Arrow)



3. Click on the Machines Memory
4. Select the Square (Black Box)
5. Click OK or Set depending on the machine

6. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



7. Click on the No Sew Icon

8. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon



9. Touch the Line

10. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



11. Select the Double Stitch Icon



12. Select the Straight Line Icon

13. Change Color to Purple

14. Click OK

15. Select the Straight Line Icon

16. Draw a Small Straight Line away from the Square in an empty space

17. Click on the Select Box

18. Draw a box around the line you just drew

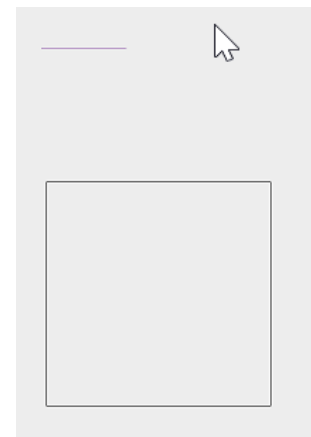
19. Click on Size

20. Adjust the Size so that the line is about 1.5" long

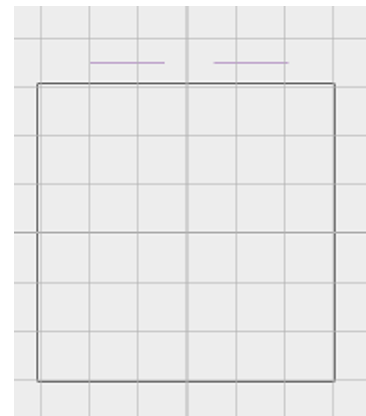


21. Use the arrows to move the line above the Square about 1/2" up and 1" over on the left side of the square

22. Click OK



23. Click on Duplicate
24. Click and Drag the copied line 1/2" up and 1" over on the right side of the square
25. Click Next
26. Click Set and Click OK when the message pop up
(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)
27. Click on Add



Creating the Tackdown Line for the Ribbon:

28. Click on IQ Designer
29. Click on the Pocket with the Arrow Icon
(For Destiny – Click on the Pocket with the Blue Arrow)



30. Click on the Machines Memory
31. Select the Square (Black Box)
32. Click Set
33. Click on the Line Region Property Icon
34. Click on the No Sew Icon
35. Click OK



36. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon



37. Touch the Line

38. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



39. Click on the Double Run Icon



40. Select the Straight Line Icon

41. Change the Color to Red

42. Click OK

43. Select the Straight Line Icon

44. Draw a line about an inch directly on top of the top of the Square Shape about 1" from the left

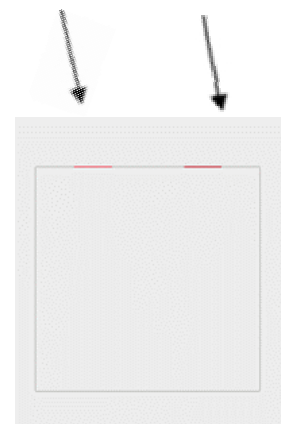
45. Draw another line about an inch directly on top of the Square Shape about 1" from the right

46. Click Next

47. Click Set and Click OK when the message pop up

(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)

48. Click Add



Creating the Tackdown Line for All the Fabrics:

1. Click on IQ Designer

2. Click on the Pocket with the Arrow Icon



(For Destiny – Click on the Pocket with the Blue Arrow)



3. Select the Machines Memory

4. Select the Red Square

5. Click on OK or Set depending on the machine

6. Click on the Line Region Property Icon





7. Click on the Double Stitch Icon



8. Change Color to Black

9. Click OK
10. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon
11. Touch the Square
12. Click Next
13. Click Set and Click OK when the message pop up
(For Destiny, Click on Preview, Next, OK, Set, OK)
14. Click Add

Creating the Final Construction Stitch:

1. Click on IQ Designer
2. Click on the Pocket with the Arrow Icon 
(For Destiny – Click on the Pocket with the Blue Arrow) 

3. Click on Machines Memory
4. Select the Red Square
5. Click OK or Set depending on the machine

6. Click on Size



7. Change the Size to 5.95”

8. Click OK

9. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



10. Select the Double Run Icon



11. Change the Color to Yellow

12. Click OK


13. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon
14. Touch the Square
15. Click Next
16. Click on Set and Click OK when the message pop up
(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)
17. Click on Memory
18. Click on Machines Memory
19. Click on Embroidery - See Steps Below

Steps to Embroider the Quilt Block:

1. Color 1 Placement Line on the Stabilizer
2. Lay the Batting on top of the Stabilizer
3. Lay the Background Fabric on top of the Batting
4. Color 2 Tackdown Line for the Fabric and Batting
5. Lay the Top Border – Align it with the stitching line Right Side Down and Tape in place
6. Color 3 Stitching Line to attach the Top Border
7. Lay the Bottom Border – Align it with the stitching line Right Side Down and Tape in place
8. Color 4 Stitching line to attach the Bottom Border
9. Fold fabric back and Press
10. Lay the Left Border – Align it with the Stitching Line Right Side Down and Tape in place
11. Color 5 Stitching line to attach the Left border
12. Lay the Right Border – Align it with the Stitching Line Right Side Down and Tape in place
13. Color 6 Stitching line to attach the Right Border

14. Fold the Fabric Back and Press
15. Color 7 Placement Line for the Ribbon
16. Fold the Ribbon in Half and Lay it on Top of the Placement Line. Tape in Place
17. Color 8 Tackdown Line for the Ribbon. Remove the Tape
18. Color 9 Tackdown Outline to Hold the Borders in Place
19. DO NOT REMOVE THE FABRIC FROM THE HOOP

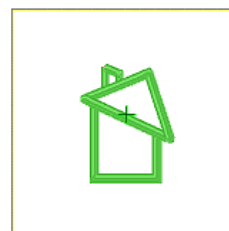
Adding the House Applique:

1. Click on Home
2. Click on Embroidery
3. Click on Machines Memory
4. Select the House
5. Click Set
6. Click on the Scan Icon 
7. Click on Scan
8. Click on Embroidery – Now you can move the house to a pleasing position
9. Click Layout or Edit depending on the machine
10. Click Move
11. Use the Arrows to Center the design – make sure the house is centered within the borders
12. Click OK
13. Click Return
14. Click Add
15. Click on Machines Memory

16. Select the Yellow Square

17. Click on Set




18. Click on Embroidery



Steps to Embroider the House Applique:

1. Color 1 Placement Line for the Base of the House

2. Lay the Purple Fabric over the Placement Line

3. You MUST click on this Icon  to go back   and REPEAT Color 1 which will tackdown the Purple Fabric in place

4. Take the Hoop off the Machine and draw a line connecting the two stitching lines.




5. Trim close to the Stitching Line and the line you just drew

6. Rethread your machine with Orange

7. Color 2 Satin Stitch for the Base of the House

8. Color 3 Placement Line for the Chimney

9. Lay the Black Fabric over the Placement Line for the Chimney

10. You MUST click on this Icon  to go back   and REPEAT Color 3 which will tackdown the Black Fabric in place

11. Take the Hoop off the Machine and draw a line connecting the two stitching lines.

12. Trim close to the Stitching Line and the line you just drew

13. You may want to Rethread your machine or keep the same Color Orange

14. Color 4 Satin Stitch for the Chimney

15. Color 5 Placement Line for the Roof of the House

16. Lay the Checkered Fabric over the Placement Line

17. You MUST click on this Icon  to go back and which will tackdown the Checkered Fabric in place



REPEAT Color 5

18. Take the Hoop off the Machine and Trim close to the Stitching Line

19. Retread the Machine with Black

20. Color 6 Satin Stitch for the Roof of the House

21. Lay the two back pieces of fabric – folded edges towards the center of the design. Tape where the folds meet. The edge of the fabric must extend beyond the stitching line

22. Color 7 Construction Stitch to put it all together

23. Remove Fabric from the Hoop

24. Trim excess fabric about ¼” from final stitching line

25. Trim corners

26. Turn Fabric Right Side Out and Press

27. AND YOU ARE DONE 😊

Fabric Measurements:

1. One Piece of Base Fabric (White) 9” x 9”
2. One Piece of Batting 8” x 8”
3. Two Pieces of Backing Fabric (Skeleton Print) 8” x 8”
4. One Piece of House Fabric (Purple) 4” x 4”
5. One piece of Roof Fabric (Orange and Black Check) 3 ½” x 3 ½”
6. One piece of Chimney Fabric (Black) 2 ½” x 2 ½”
7. Two Pieces of Border Fabric (Green Print) 3 ½” x 6 ½”
8. Two Pieces of Border Fabric (Green Print) 3 ½” x 8”
9. Two Pieces of Ribbon 2 ½”
