# ENHANCING YOUR IQ

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## GIFT BOX GREETING CARD

### Supplies:

- Greeting card or Scrapbooking card stock paper
- Medium weight Tear-away stabilizer
- Assorted colors of embroidery threads
- Machine embroidery spray adhesive

### Instructions:

- 1) Hoop the stabilizer in the machine hoop.
- 2) Lightly mist the stabilizer and place the card front on the stabilizer.
- 3) Bring up the greeting card design you just created and embroider the design using embroidery thread colors to coordinate with the fabrics.
- 4) Once the embroidery is complete, carefully remove the excess stabilizer.
- 5) You can also choose to cut another piece of cardstock sized to match the card, and glue it to cover the back of the embroidery design.
- 6) Add a personal message and share.

### Creating the Gift Box Design:



1. Click on IQ Designer



2. Click on the Shapes Icon



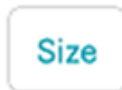
3. Select the Square



(Row 1 Column 1)

4. Click OK

5. Click on Size



6. Change the size to 4" x 4"



7. Using the arrows move the box to the bottom of the screen

8. Click on OK

9. Click on the Shapes Icon



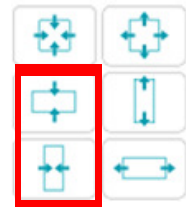
10. Click on the Square



(Row 1 Column 1)

11. Click OK

12. Click on Size – Change it so that it looks like a rectangle Approx. H=1.45" W=6.19"



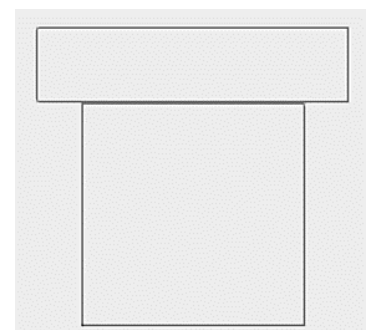
13. Use arrows




to move the rectangle on top of the square so that it is touching the square

14. Click OK

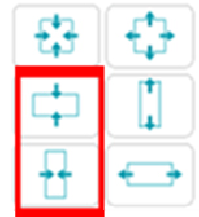
15. Click on Shapes Icon



16. Select the Square  (Row 1 Column 1)

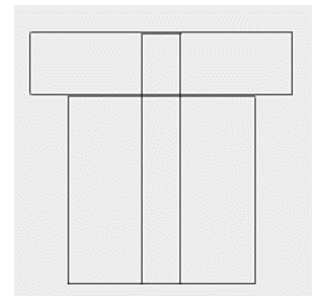
17. Click OK

18. Click Size - Change it so that it looks like a Rectangle - approx. H=5.42" W=.90"  
(the Height may need to be adjusted depending on how you placed the previous rectangle)



19. Use the arrows to move the rectangle vertically inside the previous two boxes

20. Click OK



### Creating the Bow Design:

1. Click on Shapes Icon



2. Select Closed Shapes

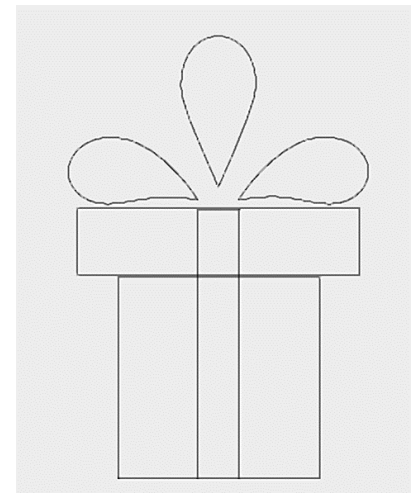


3. Select the following design  (Row 2 Column 3)

4. Click OK

5. Click on Size and use the arrows to move the bow on top of the Gift Box  
BUT this time leave space between the rectangle and the bow

6. Click OK



### Creating the Fill Stitches::

7. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon



8. Click on Fancy Fills



9. Click on Select

10. Choose Pattern 004

11. Click OK

12. Change Color to Pink

13. Click OK



14. Click on Bucket/Cup Icon

15. Click inside the left and right of the vertical box

16. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon

17. Click on Select

18. Choose Fill 007

19. Click OK

20. Change Color to Purple

21. Click OK

22. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon

23. Click inside the rectangle box

24. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon

25. Click on Select

26. Click on the Weave Fill



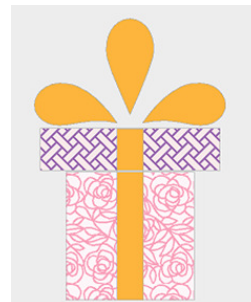
27. Change Color to Gold

28. Click OK

29. Click inside the Bow and the Vertical Rectangle Box

30. Click Next

31. Click on the Arrow until part of the Square is selected



32. Click on the Link Icon  The entire square will be selected

33. Change the size to 50%

34. Change the outline to OFF

35. Use the Arrow until the left rectangle box is highlighted

36. Click on the Link Icon



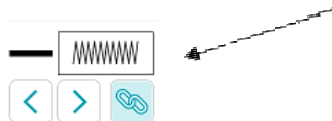
37. Change the size to 70%

38. Click on Outline and Click OFF

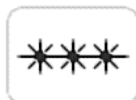
39. Use the Arrow until one of the outlines is highlighted

40. Click on Link Ion

41. Click on the Stitch



42. Change to the Candlewick Stitch



43. Change the Color to Green

44. Click OK

45. Leave the default size to .160

46. Click Next

47. Click Set and Click OK when the message pop up

*(For Destiny, Click on Preview, OK, Set, OK)*



48. Click Embroidery
49. Click on the Memory Icon
50. Save the design to the Machines Memory
