SMALL BLOCK

Creating the Block:

1. Click on IQ Designer
2. Click on the Shapes Icon
3. Select the Square (Column 1 Row 1)
4. Click OK
5. Click on Size
6. Change the Size to 2"
7. Click OK

8. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



9. Select the Triple Stitch Icon



10. Click OK
11. Change the Color to Red
12. Click OK

13. Click on Bucket/Cup for the Line Region Property



and Touch all the lines

14. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon



15. Click on the Fancy Fills Option



16. Click on the word Select
17. Select Fill #003
18. Click OK



19. Change the Color to Blue
20. Click OK

21. Click on Bucket/Cup for the Fill Region Property



and Touch inside the Square

22. Click Next
23. Change the size of the Fill to 130%
24. Click Set and OK
25. Click on Embroidery
26. Click on the Memory Icon and Save the design to the Machine's Memory

Embroidering the Small Block:

1. Hoop a piece of No Show Cutaway Stabilizer in the 9 ½” x 9 ½” Hoop along with the Background Fabric
2. Stitch Out Color 1: Fill
3. Stitch Out Color 2: Square Outline
4. You will need to embroider 6 of these small blocks
5. When you are done remove the fabric from the hoop.
6. Cut all around the block, leaving ½ Seam Allowance on all 4 sides of the block
