

FLOWER BLOCK

Creating the Placement Stitch for the Batting:




1. Click on IQ Designer 
2. Click on the Shapes Icon 
3. Click on the Square  (Row 1 Column 1)
4. Click OK
5. Click on Size 
6. Change the Size to H = 8.00" and the W = 8.00"
7. Click OK
8. Click on the Line Region Property Icon 
9. Click on the Double Run Icon 
10. Change the Color to Red
11. Click OK
12. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon for the Line Region Property  and Touch the Square
13. Click on Memory and Save the design into the Machine's Memory
14. Click Next, Set, OK



Creating the Tackdown Stitch for the Batting:

1. Click Add
2. Click on IQ Designer
3. Retrieve the Red Square from the Machine's Memory
4. Click on the Line Region Property Icon 
5. Click on the Double Run Icon 
6. Change the Color to Green
7. Click OK
8. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon for the Line Region Property  and Touch the Square
9. Click Next, Set, OK








Creating the Tackdown Stitch for the Background:

1. Click Add
2. Click on IQ Designer
3. Retrieve the Red Square from the Machine's Memory
4. Click on the Line Region Property Icon 
5. Click on the Double Run Icon 
6. Change the Color to Blue
7. Click OK
8. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon for the Line Region Property  and Touch the Square
9. Click Next, Set, OK



and Touch the Square

Creating the Placement Stitch for the Flower:

1. Click on IQ Designer 
2. Click on the Shapes Icon 
3. Click on the Flower  (Row 5 Column 1)
4. Click OK
5. Click on Size 
6. Change the Size to H = 6.00" and the W" 6.00"
7. Click OK
8. Click on the Line Region Property Icon 
9. Click on the Double Run Icon 
10. Change the Color to Red
11. Click OK
12. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon for the Line Region Property  and Touch the Flower
13. Click on Memory and Save the design into the Machine's Memory
14. Click Next, Set, OK



and Touch the Flower

Creating the Tackdown Stitch for the Flower:

1. Click Add
2. Click on IQ Designer

3. Retrieve the Red Flower from the Machine's Memory

4. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



5. Click on the Double Run Icon



6. Change the Color to Green

7. Click OK

8. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon for the Line Region Property



and Touch the Flower

9. Click Next, Set, OK

Creating the Satin Stitch for the Flower:

1. Click Add

2. Click IQ Designer

3. Retrieve the Red Flower from the Machine's Memory

4. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



5. Click on the Satin Stitch Icon

6. Change the Color to Gold

7. Click OK

8. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon for the Line Region Property



and Touch the Flower

9. Click Next

10. Change the Width of the Satin Stitch to .220"

11. Click Set, OK



Creating the Decorative Outline for the Flower:

1. Click Add

2. Click on IQ Designer

3. Retrieve the Red Flower from the Machine's Memory

4. Click Size

5. Change the Size to 6.15"

6. Click OK



7. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



8. Click on the Decorative Stitch Icon

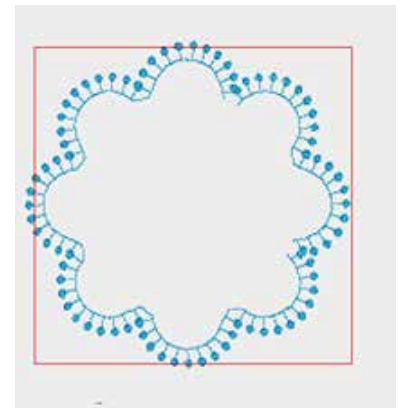


9. Click on the word Select

10. Select Stitch #005
11. Click OK
12. Change the Color to Blue
13. Click OK
14. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon for the Line Region Property
15. Click Next
16. Change the Spacing to .040" and Click OK
17. Click on the Flip Icon 
18. Select the Flip Option so that the stitch is facing out 
19. Click Set, OK



and Touch the Flower



Creating the Placement Stitch for the Inside Flower:

1. Click on Add
2. Click IQ Designer
3. Click on the Shapes Icon
4. Select the Flower (Row 5 Column 1)
5. Click OK
6. Click Size
7. Change the Size to H = 4.00" and W = 4.00"
8. Click OK
9. Click on the Line Region Property Icon
10. Click on the Double Run Icon
11. Change the Color to Purple
12. Click OK
13. Save the Design to the Machine's Memory
14. Click Next, Set OK

Creating the Tackdown Stitch for the Inside Flower:

1. Click Add
2. Click IQ Designer
3. Retrieve the Purple Flower from the Machine's Memory

4. Click on the Line Region Property Icon
5. Click on the Double Run Icon
6. Change the Color to Blue
7. Click OK
8. Click on the Bucket/Cup for the Line Region Property
9. Click Next, Set, OK



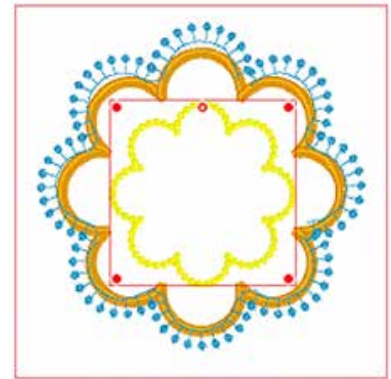
and Touch Flower

Creating the Decorative Stitch for the Inside Flower:

1. Click Add
2. Click IQ Designer
3. Retrieve the Purple Flower from the Machine's Memory
4. Click on the Line Region Property Icon
5. Click on the Candlewicking Stitch ***
6. Change the Color to Yellow
7. Click OK
8. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon for the Line Region Property
9. Click Next
10. Change the Size to .220"
11. Change the Spacing to .048"
12. Click Set, OK

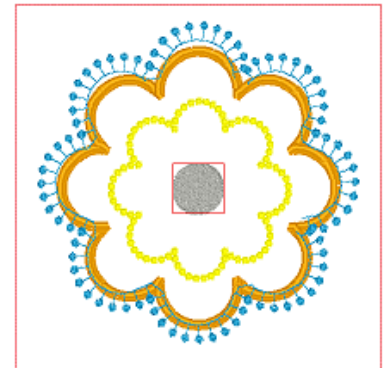


and Touch the Flower



Creating the Center of the Flower:

1. Click Add
2. Click IQ Designer
3. Click on the Shapes Icon
4. Select the Circle (Row 3 Column 1)
5. Click OK
6. Click Size
7. Change the Size H = 1.12" and the W = 1.12"
8. Click OK
9. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



10. Click on the No Sew Icon

11. Click OK

12. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon for the Line Region Property



and Touch the Circle

13. Save the Circle in the Machine's Memory

14. Click on the Fill Region Property Icon



15. Change the Color to Gray

16. Click OK

17. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon for the Fill Region Property



and Click Inside the Circle

18. Click Next

19. Click on Angle and Select Manual

20. Change Angle to 30 Degrees

21. Click Set, OK

22. Click Add

23. Click IQ Designer

24. Retrieve the Circle from the Machine's Memory

25. Click on the Line Region Property Icon



26. Click on the Decorative Stitch Icon



27. Click on the word Select

28. Change the Stitch #9

29. Click OK

30. Change the Color to Maroon

31. Click OK

32. Click on the Bucket/Cup Icon for the Line Region Property



and Touch the Circle

33. Click Next, Set, OK

34. Near the Word Select, scroll through the arrows until the square box is selected

35. Click Edit

36. Select the Stippling Icon



37. Scroll through the hoops until you see the 8" x 8" Hoop

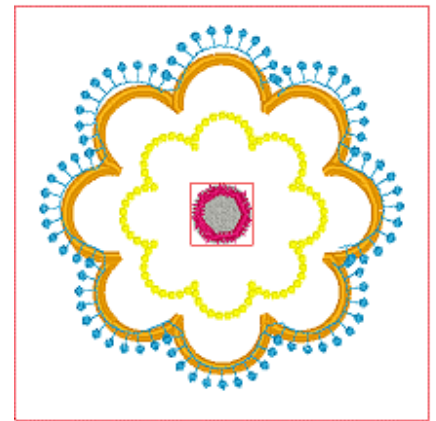
38. Change the Spacing to .280"

39. Change the Distance to .320"

40. Click OK

41. Click Embroidery

42. Save the design to the Machine's Memory



Overview of the Embroidery Process:

1. Hoop a piece of No Show Cutaway Stabilizer in the 9 ½" x 9 ½" Hoop
2. Stitch Out Color 1: Placement Line on top of the Stabilizer
3. Lay your Batting on top of the Placement Line.
4. Stitch Out Color 2: Tackdown Line for the Batting
5. Remove the Hoop from the machine and trim the batting close to the stitching line
6. Lay the Background Fabric on top of the Batting
7. Stitch Out Color 3: Tackdown Line for the Background Fabric
8. Stitch Out Color 4: Placement Line for the Large Flower
9. Stitch Out Color 5: Tackdown Line for the Large Flower
10. Stitch Out Color 6: Satin Stitch for the Large Flower
11. Stitch Out Color 7: Decorative Stitch for the Large Flower
12. Stitch Out Color 8: Tackdown Line for the Small Flower
13. Stitch Out Color 9: Placement Line for the Small Flower
14. Stitch Out Color 10: Decorative Stitch for the Small Flower
15. Stitch Out Color 11: Center Flower
16. Stitch Out Color 12: Decorative Stitch for the Center Flower
17. Stitch Out Color 13: Stipple Stitch
18. Remove the Fabric from the Hoop and Trim ¼" beyond the outer stitching line
19. You will need to Embroider four of the Flower Blocks
